

**UNDERTAKING TO BE SIGNED BY TV AND RADIO NON-RIGHTS HOLDING BROADCAST ORGANIZATIONS RECEIVING ENR ACCREDITATION TO THE TORINO 2006 PARALYMPIC WINTER GAMES**

In consideration for an Paralympic Identity and Accreditation Card (PIAC) being granted by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC), upon the occasion of the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games, to any person(s) working for

("News Organization" or "NORG"), NORG hereby agrees, on behalf of itself and all persons working for NORG:

1. To act in conformity with the IPC's "Television News Access Rules Applicable to the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games" and "Radio News Access Rules Applicable to the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games", of which NORG acknowledges having read on the IPC website  
([http://www.paralympic.org/release/Main\\_Sections\\_Menu/Paralympic\\_Games/Torino\\_2006/Media\\_Accreditation/index.html](http://www.paralympic.org/release/Main_Sections_Menu/Paralympic_Games/Torino_2006/Media_Accreditation/index.html));
2. To act in conformity with the IPC Handbook and other regulations;
3. That all still and moving images taken at the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games shall be used solely as permitted by the IPC;
4. To be filmed, televised, photographed, identified and otherwise recorded during the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games under conditions and for the purposes now or hereafter authorised by the IPC in relation to the promotion of the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games and the Paralympic Movement;
5. That PIACs are the property of the IPC and may be withdrawn at any time by the IPC, at its discretion; and
6. That any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of, in connection with, or on the occasion of, the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games shall be submitted for resolution to the IPC Governing Board. In the event of non-resolution, such dispute, controversy or claim shall then be submitted exclusively to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) and shall be determined in accordance with the CAS Ad hoc Arbitration Rules for the Torino 2006 Paralympic Winter Games. The decisions of CAS are final, non-appealable and enforceable.

Neither NORG nor any of the persons working for NORG shall institute any claim, arbitration or litigation or seek any other form of relief, in any other court or tribunal.
